OVERVIEW

Partnership for Transparency (PTF) is a civil society organization (CSO) headquartered in Washington, DC with affiliates in Asia and Europe and a special committee for Africa. We have a small staff and over 70 expert volunteer advisors and new volunteers are welcome. PTF supports innovative CSO-led approaches to reduce corruption, increase transparency and accountability, and strengthen governance in low-and middle-income economies. We envisage a world free of corruption in which citizens trust public officials and institutions and hold them accountable and responsive to their communities' needs.

OUR CURRENT PROJECTS

Since 2000, PTF has worked with over 160 CSOs in approximately 55 countries on more than 285 anti-corruption projects. Currently, we are collaborating with local CSOs on anti-corruption projects pertaining to education, environment, gender equality, health, humanitarian assistance, public procurement, and sustainable development in Argentina, Francophone Sub-Saharan Africa, India, Malawi, Moldova, the Philippines, Ukraine, and Zambia.



PTF creates knowledge products.
